Air	Sheer	Dust regularly with soft brush of vacuum.
Antero	Blackout	Fabric should be regularly dusted/vacuumed as appropriate. If commercial spot cleaners are used, they must first be tested and allowed to dry on an inconspicuous area to ensure compatibility.
Aurora	3%, 5%	Remove dust with a vacuum cleaner or compressed air. Clean with a sponge and warm, soapy water using mild detergent. Rinse with clean water. Do not scrub. Do not use solvents or abrasives that could harm the coating of the fabric. Leave the shade down until completely dry. You may also very gently rub the fabric with a clean white pencil eraser to remove small stains.
Cirrus	Sheer- 20%	Clean with warm water and mild soap. Rinse with clean water. Leave the shade down until completely dry. Can also very gently rub the fabric with a clean white pencil eraser to remove small stains.
Daybreak	Translucent	Remove dust with vacuum cleaner or compressed air. Do not scrub. Do not use solvents or any abrasive substance which might damage the coating of the fabric. Clean with a sponge or a soft brush dipped in soapy water using mild detergent. Rinse with clean water. Leave the shade down until completely dry. You can also rub the fabric very gently with a clean w hite pencil eraser to remove small stains.
Denali	Blackout	Clean with warm water.
E-Screen with KOOLBLACK	1%, 3%, 5%	Remove dust with vacuum cleaner (soft brush attachment) or compressed air. Do not scrub. Do not use solvents or any abrasive substance which might damage the coating of the fabric. Clean with a sponge or a soft brush dipped in soapy water using mild detergent. Rinse with clean water. Leave the shade down until completely dry. You can also very gently rub the fabric with a clean white pencil eraser to remove small stains.

Equinox	1%, 3%, 5%, 10%	Remove dust with vacuum cleaner (soft brush attachment) or compressed air. Do not scrub. Teton	Privacy Screen	Remove dust from the fabric surface, then wipe gently with damp sponge and mild detergent.

Zenith	Blackout	Fabric should be regularly dusted/vacuumed (soft brush attachment) as appropriate. If commercial spot cleaners are used, they us first be tested and allowed to dry on an inconspicuous area to ensure compatibility.

GreenScreen Revive	1%, 5%	Regular light dusting with a feather duster is suggested. A hand-held vacuum with low suction and brush attachment may also be used. When vacuuming, avoid pulling or stretching the fabric. Rigorous vacuuming is not recommended since this could distort the fabric. Alternatively, dirt and debris can be blown away using compressed air or a hand-held hair dryer on the cool setting.	
Infinity2	1%, 3%, 5%	Remove dust with vacuum cleaner (soft brush attachment) or compressed air. Do not scrub. Strata	Semi-sheer	Vacuum to dust with soft brush attachment. For spot cleaning, test any mild cleaning product on a small, inconspicious area prior to broad application. Do not immerse or thoroughly wet. Do not use cleaning methods involving heat, bleach, abrasives, commercial spot cleaners or solvents.
Summit	Translucent	Clean with soft brush or vacuum with soft brush attachment.

Aurora	3%, 5%	Remove dust with a vacuum cleaner or compressed air. Clean with a sponge and warm, soapy water using mild detergent. Rinse with clean water. Do not scrub. Do not use solvents or abrasives that could harm the coating of the fabric. Leave the shade down until completely dry. You may also very gently rub the fabirc with a clean white pencil eraser to remove small stains.
Dusk	Blackout	For regular care and maintenance, the excess dirt should be brushed from the fabric using a soft brush; the fabric should then be sprayed with warm water (not exceeding 100° F) and airdried. Periodically, the fabric should undergo a more thorough cleaning. Again, brush fabric with a soft bristeled brush, spray with warm water, then apply a gentle soap. Let stand for 10 to 20 minutes, taking care not to let it dry, then rinse thoroughly and air-dry. Do not use detergents and/or solvents. Leave shades down until completely dry to prevent mildew from forming.
